

# Responsibilities for OGBC Sponsored Meets 2009-2010 Season

## Attention: Levels 3-E Girls and 4-FS Boys

### Meet Commitments:

Various fundraising events as well as three (3) OGBC/OGA hosted meet are scheduled for the 2009-2010 competitive season. Our success depends on every family fulfilling their meet commitments for hosted meets and bringing their concessions donations as requested. The number of meet commitments is dependent on the number of events and meet sessions.

This season's events requiring meet commitments are as follows:

- Reverse Raffle
- Boys Meet – 2 sessions, set-up, and tear down (4 total)
- Level 1-5 fun meet – 2 sessions, set-up, and tear down (4 total)
- Girls Meet – 8 sessions, set-up, and tear down (10 total)
- Fashion Show
- Golf Outing

It is anticipated that each family will be required to fulfill **five (5)** meet commitments. These meet commitments can be fulfilled over any combination of events. Working a meet session fulfills one (1) commitment. Working the Reverse Raffle, Fashion Show or Golf outing events fulfill two (2) commitments. The Reverse Raffle, Fashion Show and Golf outing have committees in place. Attending the committee meetings, assisting in event preparation, and working the event is required in order to receive the 2 meet commitments. You must be on the committee to work the event.

Girls Levels 9, 10 and Elite and Boys Level 6 have Regional's scheduled for the weekend of April 9<sup>th</sup> coinciding with the OGBC/OGA hosted meet. In order to provide an opportunity for these families to fulfill their meet commitments, these families will be given first opportunity to sign up for a maximum of three (3) sessions for the boys meet. Level 9, 10, and Elite Girls and Level 6 and up Boys team can sign up during the first week. Sign up for all other levels begin after Monday, January 18th. (Each family other than listed above may sign up for up to (1) session for this meet.) Sign-up sheets will be located in the pro-shop.

Please remember meet commitments are based upon the number of gymnasts entered in the meets and may be revised in April. It is the responsibility for each family to fulfill their meet commitments. A fine of \$100 per missed session will be applied to the gymnast account for any missed meet commitment. For more information on fines refer to the section on fines.

Please remember committees are different and separate than meet commitments. Committees are necessary for preparing and operating the OGBC. Committee work does not count as meet commitments.

Once again this year the OGBC board is offering the opt-out program. However, only a limited number of opt-outs are available and will be accepted on a first come first serve basis until the allotment has been filled. By opting out, you will be allowed to pay \$50 for each session you are electing to opt out of. The opt-out must be received and approved by Treasurer prior by March 29th. Please note, as stated in the by-laws, if you do not sign up to help at the meet or do not show at the required time you will be charged \$100 per commitment.

### **Food contribution requirement:**

Each family is required to contribute specific food items at each meet so that our concessions can offer a well-rounded menu to our gymnasts and their guests. Two to three weeks before each meet, you will receive a food assignment sheet in your family folder in the pro-shop. It is important that you bring the specific items assigned to you.

The food assignment sheet you receive in your family folder will include instructions as to where and when to drop off your item. We have very little storage or refrigeration space in our concession area, so it is important that you bring your contribution on the assigned day.

Due to the size of the Boys meet, only a portion of families will be required to donate to that meet. The remaining families will be required to donate in April.

### **What Are The Fines for OGBC Hosted Meets?**

If you are unable to work at one or more of our meets it is your responsibility to find an alternative. Please remember, while the help of gymnasts are welcomed and appreciated, it does not count towards fulfilling the work assignment requirement. Parent participation is mandatory.

If you sign up for a session and do not show up to fulfill your commitment, you will be fined \$100 per session.

If you do not bring your food contribution to the meet, the fine is \$25.

If any of the above fines are assessed, you will receive a notice in your family folder and/or an email. Payment must be made within two weeks by check payable to OGBC.

In the event that a family has unpaid fines, your gymnast(s) will not be allowed to compete in the next scheduled meet for his or her level until all amounts are paid in full.
